

INCREASING LITERACY

Our School Partnership Ministry
mentors kids & works to increase literacy.
This year we purchased & delivered 525
backpacks and nearly 2,500 books —
5 books per child to every student at
Fairmount Park Elementary — so they can
become better readers.

REDUCING HUNGER

15,600+ meals provided through our Street Ministry, Meals on Wheels, & School Food Pantries at Melrose Elementary, New Heights Elementary, and Thurgood Marshall Middle Schools, along with our partnerships with St. Vincent de Paul, Christ UMC, & Metropolitan Ministries

42.5% increase in the number of meals provided this year
